I seem to like the native American wolf shifter stories. This story was intriguing with who turned out to turn bad.

This is a reverse harem tale of wolf shifters. Strong language and adult scenes from the start. The English is colloquial and often poor. "Melinda had forgotten her friend stood so close to her all that time." "Melinda Bartel has avoided men her entire life." While colloquial chat is fine in reported speech, it's offputting in narration.

The above mentioned Melinda is a tribal medicine woman and wolf shifter, only five feet tall, who falls in instalust with two big burly male wolf shifters. They are in wolf form for very few paragraphs. In the recent past some prejudices arose about shifter versus normal human and Native versus white (black and Asian people not mentioned) but with a baby soon to be born to the tribe, everyone is trying hard to get along with everyone else.

A disagreement arises over building a casino on tribal land. The development is tacky, will attract big business predation, draw in undesirables and will close family run shops. But presently the guys just see that it means work and could be a big income. The lady is totally against the casino, so they had better try to please her if they want her to be their mate. I am not delighted that the men had a few beers during the evening and then drove the lady back to their place. Drunk driving isn't a good example even on tribal roads. The excitement of mating stops the guys from realising that something is very wrong at the building site,

even deadly.

Most readers will just be looking for the romance but this is quite a detailed and suspenseful story, worth a look for mature readers. I like the way the men are as considerate for the lady as they can be and don't force her into anything she doesn't want.

This is book 7 of Becca Jameson's The Wolf Master's Series. Few warnings though. For those who are new to the series; the book reads are ALL CONSIDERED for AGES 18+ and NOT SOMETHING FOR WORK type of reads (unless you've mastered your public reading poker face).

This series is best read from the beginning since this IS AN ADULT Paranormal Romance that follows some (yet true) elements of BDSM depending on which book in the series your reading (IS NOT TO BE mixed up with that 50 Shades crap; the 50 shades series is NOT considered a TRUE BDSM read, which is an insult to vet BDSM readers who know the rules and follows it like breathing and eating). Book 1 in the Wolf Master's Series is called Kara's Wolves, and it is best to start your readings from there and wk your way up to this book which is Book 7 Melinda's Wolves. It is IMPORTANT to read the series if your new to it since each book picks up where the previous book left off. Also helps you not be so confused with the characters and their backgrounds. Now onto my Review for this one!

Melinda's Wolves is packed with suspense, mystery, murder, drama the works that will leave you guessing til the very end. It also picks up where book 6 left off with Rebecca's Wolves during the same time frame. Melinda and her Grandmother Mimi (both have the same psychic ability/ gift which is the gift of Foresight but Mimi's is more powerful than Melinda's) have both have an ominous feeling of dread and death concerning the recent construction of a Casino that's being built on the outskirts of their Reservation and the land it sits on. The night of the party in book 6 Melinda meets not one but BOTH of her fated mates. First up is Trace Master (you think by now its official that all the Master boy's and their extended family will be fated for a Triumvirate pairing?), who is working as a sheriff in a nearby town near the Rez. Keegan Phillips is the other of TWO men who are fated to mate with Melinda, and Trace's best friend/ long time childhood friend. Who is also the Construction Site's Building Inspector. When they all meet the shock is apparent but it takes them a few trial and errors for both Keegan and Melinda to get past his job as the casinos building inspector and all claim each other to form the bond. Melinda and Keegan are constantly butting heads over the construction and her psychic abilities warning her of danger/ death on that land. All 3 Wolves have their work cut out for them as they find a common ground and balance to forge ahead in their future. However, someone/ something is out trying to stop Keegan from doing his job as he investigate an anonymous e-mail warning him of the building support structure being unsafe and could result in multiple injuries or even deaths. Is there a simple answer to all the vandalism going on the site or is it caused by an unseen force trying to take Keegans life? Well worth the read and money. 5 out of 5 stars!
