On top of that, the chemistry between Jesslyn and Sharif is sparking up again and there is still a great deal of unresolved bitterness between them.

First, as a teacher, I wanted to cry along with Jesslyn when her holiday is rudely stolen and she's more or less forced to WORK for her whole summer. I have nightmares about closing everything up on the last day of school and then being told that I get to teach for the rest of the summer again. No thank you. So I totally empathized with Jesslyn...and much of her personality, at least as a teacher, is very much how I am as well. So I was more than able to connect with her. The characters were good, the girls were sweet, but the romance and the tension between Jesslyn and Sharif just wasn't quite wrapped up as nicely as I'd have liked. Between them, we get a couple of kisses and one love scene which ends with Sharif's anger and walking out, making

Jesslyn feel cheap and we got nothing later to balance it out. And while I really enjoyed the angst with their history, it didn't have enough denouement. It felt like there wasn't enough discussion and dwelling on each other's reasons, their feelings and excuses. I mean, they both had very valid reasons for their anger, but it felt like it all just resolved itself instantly. It needed to be more drawn out. It's a good start to the series and I'll be checking out the brothers' books. I'm wondering if evil Mom will pay them a visit.
