Blind Faith opens with a heartbreaking look inside Josh's past and paves the way for Josh and Tish adjusting to the new dynamic in their relationship.

Josh just wants Tish. Safe and sound, perfectly happy, and completely, one hundred percent, his.

I really enjoyed the dual POV, especially getting inside Josh's head. Being a badass biker, he isn't outwardly vocal about his fears or feelings but when Nancy let us glimpse them inside his head, just for ourselves? My GOD.

**“Thank you for loving me, Josh...I know you don't see it, but you do it so beautifully.”**

**He didn't see that. But he did see her.**

I loved how Nancy handled the character development of our hero and heroine. It was flawless. Instead of Josh coming across as an older, controlling man, we got glimpses inside his head that showed he was still sometimes a little boy scared that everyone's health and happiness was his responsibility.

**What if she'd gone up a ladder to get something off a high shelf and fell? She could have hurt her leg or hit her head and gotten knocked out.**

Blind Faith shows Josh on the path of being happy, finally having everything he wants with Tish, but also living in fear that it'll disappear on him. And it's in these moments that Nancy reminds us that although we are getting the swoon-worthy declarations of love inside Josh's head, he's still a bad-ass ex-con biker who will do whatever he has to do to protect Tish.

I adored Tish. The patience she exemplified when she felt Josh was being over the top or irrational really showed, in my opinion, how much she respected his feelings, knowing that there was a deeper issue behind his protectiveness. Rather than fight him tooth and nail, she approached him. Tried talking to him. Wanted to learn about him. And compromised. To me, that is so important in a story so that as a reader, I don't feel like an author is just creating unnecessary drama for the sake of a plot. Loyalty and love were always the core foundation of Tish and Josh's relationship ever since Tish was a child, and I really loved how Nancy made sure that carried through into their adult relationship as well.
