Captured and given as a present to a powerful enemy prince, Renato Kessler, Toru is given an impossible choice. Surrender himself and become Kessler's mate, or accept a life of slavery. Toru thinks he'll never be able to accept any of these choices, but at the end, choosing is really easy....

Another charming story by Delmire Hart, this one introduces us to a world where some people are gifted

with the power of dominating an element; they are few and kept secret by their Tysealean culture, and called Elementals. Toru is one of these Elementals, and his gift is mastering ice. Toru is sweet and stubborn, so he decides to join the army and fight for his country against the Rokerean invaders, even though that's forbidden for Elementals. When he finds out a minor city is left unguarded to be ravaged by the invaders, Toru decides to use his gift to stop the army to provide the citizens enough time to escape. He's decided to sacrifice himself, convinced he will die in the attempt, but he somehow survives, is taken captive and given as a present to Prince Kessler, the Rokerean Prince of war.

The first chapter of this story is painful and gory, dealing with Toru destroying the enemy army at great cost for himself. After this rough start, the book moves to the relationship between Kessler and Toru... which is delicious. Kessler is an alpha, and he's decided to conquer Toru's will, giving him freedom to choose. But he does not count on Toru's stubbornness, and his determination to fight the attraction he feels towards the handsome alpha. But despite Toru's efforts, Kessler wins his heart little by little. Toru knows what he wants to choose, but he's deeply damaged by his experiences at war, and cannot accept Kessler's offer till he feels whole and healed again. A new threat, and the chance to fight for the man he loves, may be the final boost Toru needs to make the right choice....

As I said, it is a charming story, with likeable characters and an engaging plot, and an open end which leaves the chance of another book on these two... Which I hope the writer decides to provide. I would love to continue reading about Toru and Kessler!
