"Spirits Among Us" is the second novel in "The Spirits Trilogy," and can be read as a stand-alone. While I enjoyed reading this novel, I didn't love it as much as the first novel, "Spirits in the Trees" which I thought was terrific. While the first novel was about spirits and ghosts, this novel was about an ex-FBI agent's ability to see souls that have recently departed. Even though I read the synopsis for "Spirits Among Us," I was still expecting (and hoping) to read about spirits and ghosts, to feel the same eeriness I felt with the first novel, and I believe it's because of my expectations that were not fulfilled that led me to not loving it.

While I did like both protagonists, Jon-Luc and Angela, I didn't feel the connection between them. Yes, I thought there were a few sparks when they met for the first and second time, but I thought it was all one-sided all of it coming from Jon-Luc. Whatever interest Angela had for Jon-Luc didn't come across to me. There was no chemistry or sizzle between the two, probably because the romantic angle took more of a backseat to the suspense and mystery. I was quite surprised and nowhere near close to guessing who the serial killer was when all was revealed that's always a plus in my books.

I have to mention that I didn't understand why Angela's ex-husband, Stephan, thought his reputation was destroyed because she cuts up all his pictures. I can't believe a famed photographer wouldn't have any negatives of all the photos he took. I also have a hard time believing that Stephan thought Angela was wrong about her designs being stolen. Since he does work in the fashion industry and has a stellar reputation, and Angela being a young adult with so much love and enthusiasm for the industry and her work makes it hard to believe that she wouldn't be showing all her designs to her husband.

When Jon-Luc and Angela are about to have sex for the first time, Jon-Luc asks about getting a condom and Angela replies that she's on the pill, basically to not worry about unwanted children. They also don't seem to worry about STDs since they continue on without a condom. Considering Jon-Luc is in his 30s, is sexy and gorgeous, I'm sure he's been with plenty of women. I also can't imagine any couple discussing having children after being together for the first time. Perhaps it's just me??

In the end, "Spirits Among Us" is an intriguing read and I'm sure lovers of mystery-suspense genre will enjoy this novel, perhaps even love it.
