The only issue I have with using essential oils on my dog is that he can get them in his eyes. I would have liked some hints addressing this problem. But I love essential oils and will be using these recipes.

NOT RECOMMENDED FOR THE UNINFORMED!

Much of the information here is anecdotal, not to discount its validity, but the so-called recipes are vague and unclear. At one point, the author emphasized "never use tea tree" then in another place tea tree is part of a recipe with no explanation. Tea tree can be toxic to many animals, even in small amounts, so if in doubt don't use it. Such caution is not made clear in this book.

Also, instructions like "pour into the dog's ear canal" is flat out ALARMING! The author doesn't bother to specify how much and using the word "pour" sounds like much more than would really be necessary. Never *pour* anything into an animal's ear canal!

I DO NOT RECOMMEND THIS BOOK especially for anyone who wouldn't know any better. If you do know well enough, there's nothing in here to educate you so don't waste your time.
