It was such a brilliant concept but I didn't really enjoy the authors writing style. The world building was brilliant and I completely understood where the author was going with this series; I think some people will really love this. The writing style was just a bit too basic and obvious for me. 3/5.

Fateful - It's 1910 and a young girl is saved by a handsome, and mysterious, stranger as she is about to be mauled by wolves. This book is shrouded in mystery, hidden meanings and teasers of what is to come. I really enjoyed this book, it quickly pulls you in. An enjoyable read. 4/5.

Cold Kiss - Wren tragically lost her boyfriend in a car accident. And she could bring him back. She's that kind of cool. But the consequences could be dire. I loved the temptation with this extract. I found myself wondering what I would do in Wrens situation; I love books that make me question myself and the ethics of a situation. A strong book that I'll definitely have to read now! 4/5.

A Beautiful Dark - This is a pretty typical girl meets boy at her birthday kind of story. I didn't find it exciting to find out who the mystery man was. It was frankly a bit creepy and just too typical of this genre. Not for me; it definitely needed some originality and the writing style just wasn't exciting enough to keep me interested. 2/5.

Eve - This story was highly anticipated for me; I've wanted to see what it's like for a long time. I'm glad I read it because now I know I wouldn't have enjoyed the full story. Eve is in a girls school in a country

suffering from a deadly plague. There's a lot of mystery surrounding the school fence and what's really behind it; I also really wanted to know what happened to the girls when they graduated. But unfortunately, I've read so many brilliant books like this and I can tell this won't be as gripping - it took a long time for me to get excited by the writing or the world building. 3/5.
