When I signed up for the giveaway, I was aware that it is a Christian type of novel and therefore expected the typical Christian book themes, e.g. love and God conquer all.

Unfortunately, it did not help me conquer the book. I had to give up at about page 50. I have no doubts that for a lot of people the book is absolutely perfect and well-written. For me it was irritating from the first chapter on.

The book starts with a very detailed, meticulous description of the kitchen. This style is kept up at least as far as I read. It is so detailed, that it leaves nothing to the imagination. Instead it is tiring and irritating.

The characters are annoying at best. Especially the three year old daughter who can already read, play violin, piano and has the language skills of a senior in high school and also the maturity. With every time this child appeared in the book, I felt the urge to tear my own hair out.

The marriage between the main characters has left me puzzled. So the foundation to their marriage is honesty, openness and communication.
