The life of an MC brother is full of women, sex, and a plethora of action. When the time to be with Heidi has finally arrived, Murphy must come to terms with the idea that maybe Heidi won't be waiting with open arms. What if too much time has passed? What if too much damage has been done? Can he possibly survive without her by his side?

Axel is young and in love. Full of passion for life and plenty of energy to explore Heidi, he is just starting to figure out who he is and what he wants from his life. Told in multiple POV, *More than Miles* explores each and every emotion experienced by all three main characters. As an avid reader, I have always been one to shy away from the dreaded love triangle. Who wants to escape to a place where someone will be left with a broken heart? Who wants to watch one person be left out in the cold? To make matters worse I love all three of these characters. I see Heidi as a strong young woman who is simply trying to figure out life. By her side, she has two very different men. Both contain attributes that would compliment her well. And yet we know, there can only be one. Despite my fears of a broken heart at the conclusion of this read, my desire to know who Heidi would end up with was greater than my fear of potential heartbreak, doom, and despair.
