Wrong words, missed words, random capitalization and floating letters all could have been handled with proofreading. Past tense vs. present tense and sentence structuring could've been handled with editing. The dual point of view only works if the characters each have a distinctive personality and their own voice. These characters spoke with the same voice which made it hard to know them individually. I also felt that a lot of words were wasted trying to make a point.

What really ruined it for me was the "bonus" chapter that's being held hostage until I sign up for the author's newsletter. No, thank you.

Oh well, I am a bit divided how I like the writing by the author. Sometimes they are good for a few hours of a pleasant read but then... nothing more or outstanding...:/

This book had editorial mistakes, so many this time I had hard times to ignore them and I confess I was a bit annoyed by them. This is a bit sad.:/

The character behaved a bit rushed and I am not sure, but the topic was only good enough for a pleasant read for a few hours. But not overly remarkable. It is a shame because the blurb sounded really great...

I had a few problems in connecting to the character though they weren't unlikable or annoying. There were funny scenes as well as steamy ones but the rush of emotions building up was a bit unrealistic even when I normally like insta-love.

I am also a bit sad that bonus scenes like for this story are only provided as newsletter subscriptions. With the annoying fact that the book stops really fast and around ~60% you feel a little bit cheated... I honestly expect to get a whole book, not only two thirds of it and the rest is "bonus" content which is in fact only promo for the other books. A bit of an excerpt is okay, a bit of promotion for other books is okay but please, then add the "bonus" chapter which often only are continuations after the end of the book to the edition.

Also it would be great if there would be taken more quality time to go through the edits and formatting parts... This way there can be avoid a lot of mistakes...

I give this book 3.5 stars out of 5.

That kind of blanket-scenario has a lot of good potential, especial with James on the rebound after his ex dumped him before the holidays. At first, I liked that it was not an easy "love at first sight" deal, after the first kiss they took a step back to figure out what they want. James was hesitant and Chris understanding. But then they ended up in bed together, and that scene was just soooooo crude in my opinion, it was very hard to read it. I did not care for the author's choice of words at all!!!!

I wish they could stay in the stage before, talking about their feelings, kissing and so on, because that part was so sweet and I actually got to understand and connect with the characters a bit there. I had a hard time finishing the book and the story itself was just, OK, so it just made it harder. I didn't feel like I got to know the characters at all, it was flat and sometimes I disliked them quite a bit! The story is just not written very well, and it doesn't live up to it's potential, unfortunately. It was just a string of actions one after the other without a good emotional base or connection between the two MC's.

Then audio narration was also, sadly, not so good, the narrator was a bit flat, rushing, little emotions in his tone of voice. The story could have been better with a more experienced narrator and some editing for that ending.
