Bee Carter is attempting to juggle her relationships with two men: enigmatic billionaire Nicolas and bad-boy biker Hawke. She has reached a point where choices regarding the two men must soon be made. Fear of making the wrong choice weighs heavily on Bee's mind. As if that isn't bad enough, her reputation has taken a nose-dive and she is frantic to salvage it. And her mystery admirer, what sinful request will he make next? What's a girl to do when these dilemmas overwhelm her?

Bee firmly believes that wealth is the only thing that can give her the safety and security she (and her mother) desires and needs. By association therefore, Nicolas is the only man she can spend the rest of her life with. He is also the only one who can repair her ruined reputation. Never mind that Hawke and his crew are running interference and playing damage control; Hawke can't even afford furniture for his condo. She learns though, that Nicolas might not be exactly as she assumed and there are strings attached to his "fix" for her problem. Not happy with the direction things have turned with Nicolas, she runs to Hawke for solace. He doesn't attach strings or make demands of her which, it turns out, is kind of a problem as well. He's a little too laid back and she doesn't think he really cares about her. The one true constant in her life is her best friend Cyndi and she considers their relationship a bit wobbly thanks to all of the gossip and innuendo.

I was quickly pulled into this story by the first few paragraphs but I struggled mightily with a heroine, whose primary impetus is money, and there is no doubt that wealth and its acquisition is Bee's goal. The book gave a good telling of why money was so important to her but that did little to endear her to me. Instead, the more I read the more frustrated I got with her. Her expectations of Nicolas and Hawke were shallow and her interactions with both self-absorbed. I couldn't figure out what these two men saw in her; the relationship with her mysterious admirer made more sense to me. But, maybe that is the point; Bee is deeply flawed yet both men are willing to do whatever it takes to keep her. I know it was the men who kept me grounded in the story. Nicolas might think himself a bad man but he did not force his demands on Bee. As for Hawke, I could find no fault in his character. He cares more about Bee than he probably should but it's that caring that makes the hard pill of Bee easier for me to swallow. Easy enough that I want to read the next book in the series and easy enough for me to recommend it to others with no qualms.
