I was ready for a different approach to the whole alien abduction/ existence and finally I got it.

With all due respect to all the authors who are writing about aliens, I want to say: FINALLY the aliens do not need us as breeders because they don't have women! I was so over it...

So, Kyra is working on a spacestation. Her incompetent boss, who happened to be attracted to her and fired her, managed to put the station on the path of destruction.

Kyra and her friend Phoebe are saved by Tordin an alien prince who happened to be around.

What follows is the journey of Kyra into a completely different universe and discoveries.

Having said all that, this book was definitely not that easy to read. The pace was slow and had a lot of monologues, descriptions and wholes in the plot. Most of the time I skipped the monologue pages because they really didn't work.

Half of the book was spent between descriptions, monologues and pretty boring conversations. At times there were some spiritual sparks that really peaked my interest. The romance between Tordin and Kyra was kept at spiritual level and that damaged a lot the overall story. Being the main characters they spent more time away from each other that getting to know each other. I still don't know why Tordin stayed away from his mate and why he was afraid she will see him as a god. These inconsistencies and lack of clarifications

damaged, in my opinion, the story line. It didn't feel resolved in the end. Tordin's decision to give in to the mating pull, when it happened, it didn't make sense. So, yes the romance/ attraction was lacking most of the book.

While I appreciate an independent woman and all, Kyra's new found leadership skills did not impress me even for a second. A woman who has never before been on an alien ship or planet was telling warriors what to do. It was more than unbelievable no matter how smart she was. Being the mate of the prince did not make her brighter.

The presence of Kyra's former boss (and stalker) didn't make much sense either. The fact that he hasn't eaten or had a drop of water in weeks it's just too much. Then his new found skills in hijacking the alien ship when his lack of skills destroyed a space station was a "saywhat? moment". And when I thought that the weak plot stopped there, he aligned himself with Tordin's brother. And that did it. It was wrong at all levels.

Now Kyra becoming the Goddess's "tool" was a an overkill to an already weak plot. It was like the author needed to make her shine but didn't know how.

There are a lot of biblical correlations that are used throughout the first part of the book that could explain in a way the alien's interaction with some earth civilizations but it was not explored enough. Correlated with the lack of romance and the fact that the story happened sometimes in the distant future it just didn't add up. But, I can appreciate the new approach to the whole alien-romance genre. Nothing threatens the earth or the women. Nobody wants to kidnap them for their wombs or to make them sex slaves or goodness me mate them with 1, 2, 3 or more mates.

So thank you Mychal Daniels for ending the long line of abducted and mated women.

I think a better editing would have made a whole lot of difference to the book. Less monologue, more dialogue, a bit more of character build, some more romance and this would have been a 5* story. The way it is, the book doesn't feel complete. There are a lot of things overlooked or just left hanging. And to give you an idea of what I am saying: the aliens, Tordin, Malm and Jalek are so well described while Kyra not that much. Till I read the review of a fellow reviewer I had no idea she is african american or not. Amber skin has different nuances or maybe I didn't read about it because I was skipping pages.

So the world created and story has a lot of potential and I hope that with the following stories Mychal Daniels brings some clarity to the story, a better romance and more world/ character build.

I am recommending this book to all fellow readers who had enough of the alien abduction books with predictable plots and no depth. This book will challenge your patience, will have a lot of things that do not make sense or monologues but it might be worth few hours of your time, in the end.
