After reading Memphis' story, I couldn't wait for more Rockers of Steel. I'm especially drawn to the damaged ones. Those broken bad boys that turn off their emotions and depend on sexual release to solve all their problems. It's so satisfying for me when I read about the women that change their mind and mend their hearts. And when that broken bad boy happens to be a rocker, that's even better.

I must confess that the beginning of the story was kinda confusing. I was kinda thrown into a scene where I had trouble identifying the characters and struggled to figure out what was going on. It eventually made sense, but I lost a few brain cells in the process. I lost a few more as I struggled with my impatience to learn the details of Finn's painful past. I knew he was running from his memories. That was no secret, because he flat out refused to discuss it with anyone. For some reason he went to a dark place and stopped singing. **But why? What happened?**

Finn is the least sociable of the STD's. He is not about the fans or the adoration of the crowd. His music is more personal to him. He does it for him, not for them. What happened?**

She is a stranger. She is wrapped in mystery and is as fiery as her fake red hair. She looks at him like she hates him. **But why? What happened?**

And it doesn't help when their management team throws them together. This tension gave a great start to Finn and Sonya's tale. Sexual tension and angst was at a high from the start of page one. Eventually they can't fight their urges; which sparks a relationship that neither of them planned for. But, at Sonya's request, it's kept on the DL. She's worried it will jeopardize her new job and she doesn't want an incident from her past to come to light and take away from her independence and all the hard work she's put forth.

Finn was mostly the serious one of the band. He's all about the music and never really gave in to the hype of rockstar life. Sonya was ambitious.
