Let me introduce you to this lovely little French-Korean cartoon show called Miraculous: Tales of Ladybug and Chat Noir. It started out with a PV (which can be found on youtube under Miraculous PV) and was originally going to be the first ever French anime. Ladybug and Chat Noir are part of the Quantic Universe, which is basically a super world created by Zagtoons that will be released in a series of cartoons. If Miraculous Ladybug does well, we'll be able to see more of this universe. I'll touch base on this a bit more later, first, let me introduce the characters.

Now I watched this in French, so the names that I use are different.

Anyways, this is Marinette:

She is a Parisian teenager with a love for fashion and her dream is to become a famous designer. She's a bit awkward, she stumbles, she's clumsy, and irrational. And she has a huge crush on her classmate Adrien, she gets so nervous around him that she can hardly form complete sentences. She can get a bit jealous sometimes, and she's definitely insecure at times, but the creators wanted to make her real. Which is good, he is realistic and not too overpowered. Anyways, Marinette is secretly the crime fighting superhero, Ladybug:

Ladybug (aka my next cosplay) is a cross between Spiderman and Sailor Moon. She uses a yo-yo to swing

from rooftop to rooftop and fight akumatized victims in the city of Paris. Now she has a special power called the lucky charm, which allows her to create an item that she will need to aid her in fighting evil. However, this power isn't infinite, after she uses the lucky charm she has only a few minutes before she transforms back into Marinette.

Ladybug's powers come from her earrings, aka a miraculous. Now each miraculous is different but they all have one thing in common, a kwami. A kwami is a tiny spirit? Fairy? God? We're not entirely sure yet, we just know that they've been around since the dawn of time and they are all powerful.

Ladybug's kwami is named Tikki.

She is a magical being, a fairy or something like that, and she is what allows Marinette to transform into Ladybug. She is basic advice giver, friend to Marinette, tries to convince her to talk to her crush, Adrien. Speaking of which, meet Adrien Agreste.

He is a model and the son of famous fashion designer, Gabriel Agreste.

We feel bad for him because his father is distant and we are not a hundred percent sure what happened to Mama Agreste. She's not dead, just missing.

Anyways, Adrien is forced to be this perfect gentleman b his father and he is never allowed to do what he wants. Which is why he finds freedom in becoming Chat Noir.

Chat Noir is basically just made out of bad puns and sass. Adrien loves being Chat Noir because he can do and say whatever he wants without the pressure of being perfect. Plus, he gets to see the love of his life every day.

He wants more than anything to know who Ladybug is, and he wants to tell her who he is underneath the mask as well. Who can really blame the kid at this point though? I mean, he was homeschooled, his mom left, he had no friends and she was the first person that made him feel like he wasn't alone.

Then there's his kwami, Plagg.

He's the opposite of Tikki. Instead of being helpful, he is literally useless. All he does is eat cheese and whine and complain. Literally he is me. He does care for Adrien though.

Now, onto the shipping! In this lovely show we get not one, not two, not three, but four ships for the price of one!

First there's Ladynoir, they are made of flirty banter and angst

Then there's Adrienette, the cinnamon bun ship made out of umbrellas and tears.

Marichat, the fanon sin ship

And Ladrien, which is basically two f*cking nerds blushing the entire time.

But they're the same two pe- Shhhhh!!

We have this wonderful shipper to thank for these pairings:

Master Fu is the great guardian of the miraculoues. He chose Marinette and Adrien to be Ladybug and Chat Noir. His kwami is named Wayzz, we are not entirely sure what his powers are yet. All we know is that Master Fu is this 186 year old dude with a miraculous who knows a few secrets that we don't yet. Although Master Fu is tasked with protecting the miraculoues, he hasn't been able to stop one from falling into the wrong hands.

Finally, we get to the villain of this story, The Papillion, also known as Hawkmoth.

Miraculoues are not supposed to be used for evil, but this man found a way to use his miraculous to turn every day people into monsters by feeding off of their negative energy.

His kwami, Nooroo, explained to him that if one were to combine Ladybug's earrings and Chat Noir's ring, they would obtain Godlike power. So, naturally, he wants this ultimate power. But why? Why would this man want this ultimate power? Could it be because...

Umm...

Okay, let's not jump to conclusions. We don't know if Gabriel Agreste is the one turning innocent people into monsters. It's just, there's evidence for and against the claim. There's the whole thing about his wife, we know that she isn't dead and it's been hinted that she might of had a miraculous too (damn Adrien, what is with your family and miraculoues??) Sadly, until season two finally premieres we are clueless.

There's a bunch of other characters, like Lila, who claimed to be a miraculous holding superhero called Volpina when really she was just an akumatized victim. She may be important later.

There's also Alya, Nino, Chloe, so any others that I'm forgetting, but by this point I'm just basically retelling the entire freaking show.

That's it, that's the whole show. Now only the first season of this show has premiered and a season two and three are currently being worked on. This show is wonderful, it's funny, there are interesting characters, it's great for everyone. Ladybug and Chat Noir may be lighthearted and childish, but they started out completely different. This show was originally intended for a much older audience and it was going to deal with serious political issues. Ladybug and Chat Noir were completely different as well, instead of being the goofy children that Marinette and Adrien are, their original concepts (Felix and "Bridgette") were changed drastically. Their partner dynamic changed, their relationship changed. However, audiences didn't respond well to this concept. So Felix was scraped and turned into Adrien, and Marinette's personality was only slightly altered.
