I enjoyed this book overall. I suppose my biggest complaint involves the pacing of this book, because I was actually surprised when I turned the page and realized I was at the end. In a lot of ways, I felt like the story was really just picking up. I think part of that sensation involves how much introduction we get to the harem members. A reverse harem book is only as strong as the characters in the harem, but we're really still barely getting to know some of them by the end. Obviously, this is part of a series, so the author has time to establish these characters, but I really would have liked this book more if the characters were more firmly established by the end of this book; as it is, some of them still seem somewhat flat. I know this author is capable of handling this issue better because Crash is also the first book in a series, but I still felt like the characters were all round and distinct by the end of the book. I've been looking forward to the release of Wicked Fae, so I think I was a bit let down that I didn't get more development in the first book. I'm not really excited about having to wait for more of that development, especially since I'd rather get the sequel to Crash first.

My only other complaint involves how Puck's character was handled. I think it's an interesting idea that makes sense for the legendary Puck, but I felt the execution of it left something to be desired. I often wasn't sure which form Puck was in, and I suppose it doesn't really matter, but I feel that it sort of defeats the purpose of having a character with multiple forms if you don't specify which form the character is in. It just made it hard to fully picture some of the scenes with Puck. Still, I really liked the premise of the book, and the characters seem promising!
