I liked being back with the two original characters as although you have a sense of what's going on with them in the other novellas this short story does allow you to get more of a feel for their life and their business, particularly the expansion of Chalet Repos.

Although neither Jake nor Emily is open to being paired off together the chemistry between them is absolutely undeniable.
