I was really torn with rating this book. Even while writing this review, I'm torn. I enjoyed this book and it proved to be a fast read. I have also read some of the later books in the series and finally got the chance to read the book which started the series. I can see where the Author has grown as a writer. For me this was fun, escapism reading.

Penny is a nineteen-year-old college student who bumps into a man in a coffee shop. Her coffee spills on her and he offers her his sweater to wear as an apology. She accepts while noticing how good looking the man is. What could have been an innocent encounter turns serious when she shows up for her first class and is shocked to see that the man who gave her his sweater is her professor, James Hunter. Lust and longing enter stage left...

They have instantaneous lust and longing for each other which is complicated by him being her professor and also because of a fellow student who wants to be more than friends with Penny as well. Both throw

caution to the wind and enter into a relationship.

Forbidden romance full of angst, secrets, and false assumptions. Some of the characters are immature and I wanted to take and shake them. I wasn't a big fan of her roommate and at times, Penny's immaturity was annoying. At times, I wondered what a twenty-seven-year-old professor who once had his own company would see in her. Having read some of the later books, I can say that she does mature and shows growth in later books. Plus, he is her professor.... I kept thinking of all the legal, ethical and moral issues that would come into play of a professor becoming involved intimately/romantically with a student. Talk about a book coming out of nowhere and blowing you away!

Now I gotta say, I don't normally reach out and read a lot of forbidden love/taboo reads. I'm a sheltered soul, I know. It just doesn't normally jump out at me so I'm not as experienced as some in that arena. So this serial/series of books was definitely a step out of my comfort zone, but one that now that I'm finished was well worth it.

It needs to be stated right from the start that this is an ongoing serial/series read that does end with one hell of a cliff-hanger at the end of book three. It's going to make you want the books that follow. And for this reader, I already went and bought book 4 because after what I just read in the three books previous, I need more and won't be able to settle until I get it.

Temptation follows Penny as she starts her sophomore year of college, complete with a chance meeting with

none other than the man that will become her Communications Professor, James Hunter. A man that despite her attempts otherwise, she can't help being drawn and attracted to.

What I enjoyed about this story and the couple as a whole is that what takes place between Penny and Professor Hunter didn't just start right away. There was attraction, sure. It was there and it was simmering until it finally exploded, but I enjoyed the buildup to get to the explosive parts. The push and pull. The attraction they both seemed to be unable to fight.

And when we do finally get to the point where they give in, man, explosive was a pretty adequate description. I don't actively search out steam in my books. I don't need it in my romance reads (or any reads for that matter), but what was present in this story was off the damn charts. It was the complete opposite of the emotional and angsty books I've been reading of late and gave me everything I needed in the rough and raw category.

But past the steam, I was into this couple. I saw something in them besides the carnal desire they had in their private moments together that spoke of a deeper bond being created and I couldn't help the deep seeded need in me to have it work out for them. After what Penny had been through with an ex, and with how Professor Hunter came across—the edginess that spoke of his own issues in the past—I wanted them to work. And they did work. Very well in fact.

Well, they did when they didn't have outside forces splitting them apart. Making them doubt themselves, what they shared, or even themselves.

There were multiple instances throughout these three books that made me literally holy shit while I was reading. They're all moments that I suppose could have been predictable or rather, expected, and they were for me, but the way in which they were delivered was done in such a way that I was just not ready for it. I wanted more of Penny and James first. The delivery in these cases was phenomenal.

I'm pretty sure I was hooked on Professor Hunter as Penny was come to think of it. I was greedy in how much more I wanted with him...and in the end, them.

What I didn't expect with this after being so into the main characters was to like the other characters so much.

I enjoyed Penny's best friend. I felt that she was portrayed very well (especially in the third book) and then Tyler. I wanted to hate Tyler after what happens in the first book but as time wore on, I sometimes found myself torn between him and Professor Hunter. He was just written that well. I have to say that if I wasn't already invested in Penny's relationship with James, Tyler would have stolen my heart here. Hands down. I would have wanted the two of them together. He was the safer choice.

But this story is about safe. It's about forbidden, and in the end, what the heart of the two people involved want. And in this case, it's each other. Even if they have to leave trails of broken hearts in their wake. (Don't worry Tyler, I'll take you and keep you forever ;))

Pacing was great here. For a serial, it's expected by me honestly and it was delivered well here. I didn't have lulls in the story or moments where I felt that it moved to fast. It was steady all the way through and made what should have probably felt like a longer read, short. Before I knew it, I was reaching the last page and pulling my hair out over the way it ended and needing more.

I've never had the pleasure of reading this author before, but now that I have and I've seen her writing style, how she brings characters to life and even the serious level of steam in her work, it definitely won't be the last time I experience her.

This story keeps you invested so much so that you have to read the next book to know what happens. I know I did!

2 stars - the author has the ability to craft and structure a story (albeit in need of some editing), but I was disappointed with the characters and the ending.

My first impression of Penny was that she had to be a high school girl. Her immaturity continued to show throughout the rest of the book. I was especially disappointed when she ran from James (without questioning what she found in his bedroom) to Tyler and used him. Good for Tyler for walking away. He deserved better. I was often thrown out of the plot. Penny was supposed to be a sexual novice (Austin had been her only partner and presumably for a short period of time), yet she gave James head like she was Linda Lovelace. What the heck was up with her constantly calling him Professor Hunter even while they were intimate? In those moments, Penny seemed like a 12-year-old who wasn't allowed to address an adult by his first name. I kept thinking that James would turn out to be the villain. Why would a 27 year-old handsome, rich, Harvard graduate--who could easily find a woman who was his intellectual equal--be interested in awkward and insecure (and sometimes not very smart) Penny unless there was something wrong with him? I was waiting to see if he got off on dominating young girls who wouldn't fight back.

If it wasn't for the hot sex, this book would be tagged YA due to Penny's angst and the inability to understand what was up with James (his POV would have been helpful).

The COMM classroom scenes felt like grade 9. The speeches were simple and the professor's directions lame. Each of the classes felt like they lasted about 10 minutes after he talked, handed out papers, then dismissed everyone.

Lastly, I didn't appreciate the lack of resolution at the end of the book. In any romance, the hero and heroine have to end up in a good place even if it's not a HEA. Ms. Smoak should have placed the ending where James and Penny want to be together regardless of the complications and hinted at subplots that could unravel everything in book 2. I have no doubt that the ending of Temptation would have been rejected by a traditional publishing house because readers hate to be tricked and conned into buying book 2. This reader is done with James and Penny.
