The woman looks like and might even be Habaek's first human wife, Nakbin but he doesn't believe it. Certainly some of the gods are conspiring to do something. General Hyue takes Soah away since Habaek is in a bad mood, taking her to his hometown, a place of great beauty, an act the others try to use to sow seeds of mistrust in Habaek's mind.
