Mountain Ambush: Echo Mountain is a Love Inspired Suspense by Hope White. It is set in the mountains of Washington State. The book deals with making decisions and not accepting guilt and blame that are not yours.

Dr. Kyle Spencer is a member of the Search and Rescue team and takes his profession seriously. It is the only thing that matters. He has learned to shut off his emotions and his self from others. He isn't anti-social; but spends as much time as possible helping others as a doctor. One day, he receives a text from Gwen, a young girl who is involved with drugs but seems to want a way out. She is out on one of the mountain trails and is possibly committing suicide. Dr. Spencer is not one to put things off because they may be rough. He heads up the trail at a run to get to Gwen as soon as possible. He finds Gwen but she is severely hurt. As he tries to help her, he is ambushed and his opponent is hoping he will give up; but someone interferes – Maddie McBride.

Maddie keeps Dr. Spencer from being kidnapped and then helps him as he saves Gwen. He is acting strangely and as a paramedic, she thinks he has a concussion and insists he be taken to the hospital. Spence which he prefers to be called, hates the hospital. Maddie feels, rather than knows, that Spence is attracted to her; but due to a past with a fiancée, he would rather avoid women.

Avoiding Maddie is almost impossible because someone keeps attacking Spencer before he can even get well from the fall. Who is out to kill Spence but to kill his reputation, make him lose his medical license, and to kill him? What has Maddie jumping right in with him?

The book is excellent with loads of action.
