Hairy Bromance is an oddly entertaining book. It's full of monsters, but they're not quasi-scary, mindless beasts. They're like normal people who just happen to be monsters. While the two main characters Glen and Barry are a Sasquatch and Werewolf, the book has just about every other monster imaginable. Some I even had to Google to figure out what they are.

The story is simple: Glen and Barry get run out of their homes after they allow photographic evidence of them to show up in their local paper. The most logical thing to do?
