The third book in this series focuses on Carter, the third owner of Club Zodiac. He's attracted to Brooke, a shy, introverted redhead who has been working with Faith, Rowen's partner, on exploring the BDSM lifestyle.

Brooke is very skittish; so much so, she barely looks Carter in the eye. He's desperate to know her better, and finally gets the chance when she hits absolute rock-bottom. With no one else to turn to, she allows Carter to help her.

She's nervous about asking him for help; for so long she's literally had no one in her life. He slowly coaxes her out of her hard protective shell and discovers her horrific past.
