She gets a brilliant idea to seduce Bram, the alpha to the Stonefire dragon clan. Now she's not genetically compatible to bear dragon shifter babies. That's actually a requirement to work at the DDA. Ok let's start with the things some people (myself included) need to know because we skipped reading the blurb :) This is a serial which means it is only one episode or part of a whole story. This part is about 50 pages, and it is the first part of the story. It leaves you wanting more, and you have to wait for it because this serial is not complete yet. Stonefire Dragons #1-4 is the first story and a complete serial series. If you are not sure whether you are a serial fan, I'd start with the first set first.

Okay, I think Jessie is my favorite serial author :) That's not to say that I don't scream and yell that I want the Stonefire books to be full novels while reading them ;) She does such an awesome job with her serials.
