In all throughout the novel you can see she really enjoys sex and some of the scenes between her and her clients during their Cosplay adventures are pretty steaming hot!! She keeps a diary at home of when she is going to meet someone, who she is going to meet (even if it is a fake name they have given) where they are going to be so should she ever go missing or anything happen to her because even though she knows she enjoys her work, it's still a dangerous game.....
