The hero and heroine were once engaged, but things ended badly and they haven't spoken in five years, but this case has throws them together when Macy's name connects her to the baby that was dropped off at the FBI office. Tanner is tasked with the duty of figuring out what Macy knows. But Macy can't figure out how she is connected. The action begins almost from the first page and doesn't let go until almost the end. Just when I thought it had calmed down a bit for the characters to catch their breath, something else happens keeping them on high alert. I really loved these characters. Macy was a nurturer and it was no surprise how quickly she connected with the baby.
