Despite taking months to read Sharp Objects (work , time, etc...) I read the bulk today. I was interested from the beginning and curiosity took a while before it started to put two and two together to come up with the guilty ones in this disturbing thriller. The inhabitants of small town suburbia 'Wind Gap' are clear cut with their old money types vs the rougher, poorer workers , the incompetent local police, plethora of bars, the potential for idyll in the woods and play spaces scarily made no- go areas. The stepford wife types are portrayed brilliantly humorously (dreadful people!)

The voice of the piece , Camille, let's us see the story from her disjointed point of view. The narrative of the case littered with her own deeply disturbing history of self abuse . Thematically there is lots going on. No spoilers here! We don't really get anything about the formal investigation until the end, when Camille has already worked it out. She is a user and she is used. We do sympathise with her though. As for her half sister, Amma, she is never likeable.

Dysfunctional people all over the place. I noted just 3 truly sane characters in its 300 pages. 2 or them are distant from Wind Gap and are not really involved in the story at all.
