I've been reading a lot of Zoe Chant's books recently, on a bit of a urban fantasy and paranormal romance kick. I've enjoyed her works a good bit, actually, and this one was no exception. She usually has good banter between characters, a bit of steam, and at the longer novella/short novel length, these make for quick, fun reads.

This one had a sweet feel, even with the suspense with de Jager and the bit of steam between the leads. His punny sense of humor aside, I liked how Jack (H) was a little lonely. All the alpha protectiveness and assertiveness, but still a little vulnerable and excited about being accepted by Toni (h). I also like tigers (cats in general). Toni was dealing with something a lot of us deal with. No matter how close you are with your siblings, there's always opportunity for sibling rivalry and feelings of inadequacy. I liked how she dealt with those feelings and how she came to accept her own place and worth (well, maybe not full acceptance - it's a short novel after all - but she was at least moving towards all that).

There were a few little editing goofs, continuity errors, that made me wonder if this was one of her earlier works? They were just a little more noticeable, i.e. the twins were referred to with two different ages (8 and 10) at different points, and de Jager referred to Toni with a different last name than what she used throughout the book. That sort of thing. The one that got me, though, was one that probably wouldn't have bothered most readers. Jack mentioned that de Jager and he met on the "hot" tundra in South Africa when he opened his first reserve. Tundra are arctic, Antarctic, or alpine. There are no tundra in South Africa, and if there were, they'd be cold, not hot. Like I said, most probably wouldn't be bothered by this one sentence in 120-something page book. But with a background in biology and geology, it stuck wrong in my mind. One of those stupid little things I know.

Still, it's another quick, entertaining read from Zoe Chant. Minor details and goofs aren't going to stop me from reading more of hers.
