Summary/Reason for Rating: This concept book teaches younger children about different kinds of trucks. I rate this book a 5 because all the images are real photos of trucks, such as a big rig, fire truck, bulldozer, and a tow truck, and the simple backgrounds. I like the fact that children are exposed to real images of trucks they will see on the street, compared to replicate drawings. The images are in true color and show details of each truck. On each page, the background is a different solid color, exposing children to learn their colors and helps readers to focus on the trucks.
