I first discovered Kirsty Moseley back in May of 2012 when I stumbled across her self-published novel, *The Boy Who Sneaks in My Bedroom Window* (<http://www.goodreads.com/review/show/...>)

Now, after reading *Always You*, my thoughts are pretty much the same; a little all over the place. Perhaps my KM love stems from my best friends fall in love "g" spot, but there's just something about Kirsty Moseley. It's like she gives me literary beer goggles every single time I read one of her books. I see the flaws, I know the flaws, but I just don't care. I mean, I care...but I don't.

One thing that seems to be a common occurrence in KM books is the lack of parental...well, parenting. Either

the parents are pretty much non-existent or their blasé carefree parenting is a little unrealistic. Who are these people?? Teenagers sleeping in the same bed and running off to Vegas; it makes so much of the story implausible, but isn't that one of the great things about fiction? You can manipulate and redefine plausible to make your story work. Kirsty Moseley does this and she does this often, but she does this well.

I didn't like *Always You* as much as *TBWSIMBW* and I completely understand the negative reviews. I had some of the same thoughts, but at the same time there was just something about it.
