The plot of the second book of the Time Series centers on main characters Robert and Kathy Upton, who travel back in time to chase a fellow (!) time traveller who apparently, is up to no good. Although I enjoyed some of the new characters introduced, the overall plot seemed weak and rather unnecessary. It almost felt like the author had a hard time figuring out a plausible scenario for sending the couple back to the 1700s, but she reeeally wanted them to go there. As I read, I wanted to feel as though Robert and Kathy had NO CHOICE but to go back in time or that falling through the time portal was accidental again - like it was in the first book of the series. In reality it felt like they made a choice and just decided to take an adventure based on some very sketchy "what if's."

The payoff after reading the climax wasn't worth it for me. I wasn't even excited; it was like, "Meh." I

honestly just wanted to finish the book and see how it ended because I already felt so invested. :/

All in all I gave this book 3 stars because it did entertain me in some parts, but the plot was lacking and the villain seemed boring. There were also various typos scattered throughout which detracted my attention away from the story. I fear my time with the Uptons has come to a close, and I'm in no hurry to rejoin them.
