First I want to say that the reader should defiantly have read Perfectly Toxic before reading this book as the plot of this book is greatly tied to the things that happened in that book. So with that said I will try not to give away spoilers but some things will reference the other book.

Harrison has always been a tortured soul do to his past with his brother. When he is taken by a sick and twisted pair of killers in PT his tortured soul is added to tenfold. He has been distancing himself from his

ATL teammates due to an internal rage he had since been fed drugs that he thinks have altered his personality. He wants to find the only other living subject to have been given the drugs the scientist (from the previous book) used on them.

Liam Forrester was the man that was kept and tortured the longest from the killers in the previous book. We knew he was a bit mad at the end of the book and also had become a killer himself. I could not believe what the author did to this poor soul who turns out to be a schizophrenic who the scientist did manage to get rid of his other voices but ended up leaving a surprising one still in his head that now has him on a killing spree.

Liam's sister Kiera has been trying to take care of Liam for 10 years since their parents died. That has not been easy and she is also keeping a pretty big secret. Harrison decides to use Kiera to find her brother but doesn't count on actually falling in love with her.

Along with having those 3 POV we also have 2 female detectives who are on the case of trying to find the killer in a bunch of recent deaths of women.

Perfectly Tortured is PERFECTLY WRITTEN - - You really need to at least read Perfectly Toxic (C.O.R.E. Above the Law, #2) to completely grasp the intensity of this book , to truly understand what horrific experiences that Harrison and Mel and even Liam endured at the hands of the sadistic Adeline.

Desperate to stop a madman, Harrison puts both his life and his sanity on the line when he starts dating Liam's sister, Kiera to get close enough to Liam to prove his guilt and hopefully stop the brutal slayings. Harrison hasn't had an easy life and continues to question his own worth, let alone even allow himself to dream of having somebody like Kiera fall in love with him. . . and fears if she finds out that he started dating her only to get close to Liam, will leave him, which to him validifies that he is truly unworthy of love.

Kiera has fought her own demons her entire life, taking care of a brother with a severe mental illness after the suspicious deaths of their parents has taken its toll on her - - - she has sacrificed everything for Liam. Liam on the other hand does everything he can for him - - and for Adeline who basically controls him through her unquenchable thirst for blood - anybody's blood - and she relentlessly pushes every button that she knows will trigger Liam to kill, sometimes just to shut her up.
