Wicked Hot is a high-octane, action packed adventure focusing on the way in which the covert missions each of the characters undertakes mesh together and affects not only their lives but the lives of those closest to them.

With multiple perspectives the narrative makes clever use of third person narration in order to keep tight control of the separate plot threads. I have to be honest and say I did feel a little lost at the start due to references to previous incidents I wasn't sure if they had appeared in Gennita's own series or not. Little snippets of information are provided on numerous characters but lacked a lot of development leaving me feeling only a surface connection to the story as a whole.

With super soldiers, assassins, spies, Navy SEALs, remote viewing, super gadgets, terrorists, hostage negotiations, black ops and conspiracy theories take up the majority of the plot with small pieces of a relationship between NSA/CIA fixer Kirk and GEM operative Surya. Little pieces of information regarding a previous interaction between Kirk and Surya provide a little understanding to the intensity of the chemistry between them.

While Wicked Hot is fast paced and adds a lot of detail to the careers of the major players in the Mackenzie series, for me it lacked the romance, heat and passion I have come to expect within the MacKenzie world.
