I was a fan of the original fanfiction story and followed it very closely. So, when I found out that Melody was turning this mammoth of a story into a real novel, I was thrilled and immediately bought it, wanting to be supportive of my fellow fanfiction writers and because I remembered enjoying the story so much online. However, what I had forgotten was how almost cliched the whole thing was. The narration was not too sophisticated, dialogue predictable, characters sometimes only one-dimensional. If there's one thing I could critique about the style, it would be her over use of telling and not showing. The characters--whether it was Lena and Tristian (I love their name changes) or the barely present Felicity or kid who walked down the hall--I felt like I knew them on the same level because everyone was described the same. It felt like there was no real depth to the characters beyond what I was told, which was everything. I was never left guessing at anything or wondering what was going to happen because I already knew, and not just because I'd read it before.

But, that's not to say that I didn't like the novel. Despite being slightly predictable, it was fun, a classic teenage read about a guy and girl who shouldn't fall in love but do and the crazy high school things they coincidentally find themselves doing. It's light and fluffy, something you read to make you smile a little bit or just to escape for a few minutes. It doesn't take itself too seriously which I thoroughly enjoy.

I await more fantastic stories from Melody and eagerly anticipate her updates on fanfiction. (If you're looking for her on there, just search "Welcome to Drama Academy," and her pen name will pop up.) One can only hope that she will mature as a writer and find her place among novelists. A round of applause for you!

Also, housekeeping note--be aware of several (and by several I mean a ton) of editing errors. The editor did a terrible job of checking over the manuscript before submitting it, and, as a result, there are several spelling, stylistic, grammar errors that any competent editor should have caught and changed. I hold none of these to Ms. Mason's credit as it is the editor's job, but I just wanted you to be forewarned.
