Reading in chronological order is not necessary but advantageous.

The set up in this book is similar to that in Amanda M Lee's Wicked Witches of the Midwest series. The lead character in both series are witches who are journalists from a family of witches. Both have a great aunt who is cantankerous, two cousins and two aunts who make a living from boarding houses. Their fathers are absent, and each has a simmering love interest. There the similarity ends. Like the seventh son stories, the similarity of formula does not distract from an enjoyable read.

The Protagonist: Harlow Torrent is our female sleuth who is an online journalist. She is also a Slip Witch, which means that her powers as a witch are always changing. That is advantageous as she can see and do things other witches cannot. However, Harlow is coming into her powers. So things get a little unpredictable.

The Plot: Harlow is on site, to cover the construction of the Mud Race assault course when workers discover human bones. They belong to a young girl called Holly and her father. Holly's ghost, visible to Harlow, asks her to investigate their deaths. Harlow is reluctant for good reasons, not least she has been frozen for the last six weeks!

Harlow is a charming character, and the situations she finds herself in are amusing. This story follows straight on from the first book. Harlow returns to the present after six weeks in stasis. To the world at large, the family has said she was in France. It can get tricky when directly asked questions about a place you have never been too.

The book is warm and well written. I like how Lake has managed to have the aunts and cousins rubbing up against each other without being condescending or churlish. The characters are enjoyable and the subplots interesting. Harlow's rivalry with the printed newspaper owner and her addiction to the power of fire had me smirking.

Treasure Witch is an entertaining cosy mystery designed to make you smile.
