Due to the economy downfall, Mia found herself in need of extra cash in order to make ends meet and still provide financial support to her parents. Her answer comes in an email forwarded to her from a previous client. This gig offers \$5,000 dollars!! Definitely enough to help her out, however, what would her boyfriend and family think if they ever found out? Even if she decides the job is not for her, the email states that she can keep the money for her discretion. So Mia ponders with the idea, Why not? There's a saying: Curiosity kills the Cat!!

Characters: Mia is a six feet overweight woman with a sense of humor that could have made her a member of queens of comedy. As with many overweight people, Mia endured teasing for being overweight.
