Half the book is filled with unoriginal boringness, such as shopping. If I wanted to read a story about shopping, I wouldn’t pick up a paranormal book. A bit disappointed with this segment.

The story is not bad, but it’s not amazing. It kind of rolls along taking you with it. I find that Aria does a lot of simply sitting around being protected. She eats a lot of pizza. She works in her crappy job. I think for some amazing thief, I expected her to be a little more kickass.

The reverse hareem element is mild at best. I think she has sexy times with two guys in this book. The same

two from the last but to be honest, I already can't really remember. It's not overly descriptive. I guess my feeling is that if you are going to go down that path then go down it properly! It feels a bit like it's half one kind of book and half another. Everytime she touches dragon blood she gets unbelievably horny - ok great. Then one of the guys ask her if she's horny - yes, she is, she confirms. Then they just shrug and go solve some part of the mystery and get a pizza... *record screeches* What? What happened to the unquenchable lust? Oh yeah, right, raincheck! I'm confused. Is this an erotic novel with an attempt at a storyline or is this an action adventure with a few sexy times. I like both, but I kind of want to know what I am getting.

On top of this, I think the problem with any serial is that there are always strung-out moments which feel a bit like 'fillers'. This book felt like a filler. The first book is all scene setting and action. The second book gives you some progression and some full-on sexy times you've been anticipating. The third book? Just plods along.

But they are short and entertaining, like watching a short episode of a TV show. I like that I can read one in an evening. This one ended with an interesting development so I'll probably read on, but I don't know how memorable they are.

We also get to see more of the main antagonist, who is quite scary and powerful. The one main issue I have with this series, including this book, is that each book ends on a cliffhanger. I'm interested enough in the story that I don't need a cliff hanger ending to keep me coming back for more so it's a bit frustrating, but not enough to put me off from reading the next book.

For the first few chapters, I feel a little disoriented, trying to reconcile the Aria that I've come to adore from before to the current one I'm reading. It's just that I think before meeting the princes, she seems like a no-nonsense, cool girl. I'm not sure if it's because of the way the guys isolated her in hopes of giving her space. But she's kind of, in a sense, crippled by that so she came off as someone...whiny. Her dialogue during that time is...less than bearable. And it makes sense that when she came out of her funk, she took charge and engaged herself to the cause, she's more fun to read.

The guys...I'm having problem distinguishing who's who, sorry. It's like I replace all of them with one another. Except for Erik, because he's the temperamental one. When last we left Aria, betrayal and perfidy had reared their ugly heads. Pete is dead. Silas is devastated. While Aria and her mates know exactly who's to blame, it seems nothing can be done. But there are far bigger problems on the horizon. A curse by Gideon Zyrian, the Dark Dragon, has drained magic from the world for centuries. As if that wasn't enough, he's finally ready to take his revenge on the dragon princes. Why? Hatred, revenge, sheer insanity...take your pick. When Zyrian comes after the dragon princes' most precious possession, even their might and magic may not be enough. But there are surprises waiting in the wings. Aria's already shown she's no ordinary Norm. Just who is she? Maybe the better question is what is she? With her past shrouded in mystery and no answers to be found, Zyrian's attacks grow bolder. Desperation leads Aria and her mates to Castle Jaeger where the past and the future collide with explosive revelations. Is Aria the key?
