The Prince's Christmas Vow is a story of new beginnings and second chances at love. I was immediately hooked with the story the minute I read the synopsis, it's one of those stories that I knew I was going to love and it didn't disappoint at all.

When Crown Prince Demetrius Castanavo used to still be in his playboy ways he met a young interior designer, Zoe Sarris who he secretly got married to without anyone of his family knowing about it. Needless to say, it was an scandalous event that completed changed their lives, especially when Zoe was forced to leave the prince for good by his family. Now she has come back to his life after he requested her interior design services. With the hopes that they can put their personal past behind them, she shows up at the palace only to find that she still has feelings for the Crown Prince. I have this fascination with the storyline where a commoner falls in love with royalty or a movie star or some bigger than life personality. And as long as it doesn't cross some sort of line (like I'm not a fan of the boss/employee theme), I'm usually good. I like seeing that some person who is just living life and not gold-digging just happens to fall in love with someone whose circumstances are different than their own. And we get this in The Prince's Christmas Vow. And on top of that, it's set at Christmas time and it's a reunion story.

I'll admit, that when I first started reading, I wasn't sure if I was going to like the story. Secret marriage that didn't last long, then reunited... what's going to happen? I wasn't thrilled with the ultimate reason the marriage broke up because honestly if they'd just talked it probably wouldn't have happened. But at the same time, both characters grew up a lot during the year and half or so they were apart and that makes a big difference on how they handle situations.

Zoe is an interesting character. She's an up and coming designer who just happens to have been married to a prince. She believes their marriage was annulled, so she's surprised when she's asked to work on a project he's heading. She needs the money, so she plans on doing her job and staying out of his way. But of course, he doesn't really let her do that.

Prince Demetrius' wife left him with no explanation, but she also never finalized the annulment. When his project needs an interior designer, he hires Zoe because she's the best, but also to give him a chance to finally end their marriage. But when they see each other again, sparks are flying and he's more interested in answers and a possible reconciliation.

Zoe and Demetrius work well together. You can tell that their short lived marriage was passionate, but fear took hold of Zoe and sent her running. Then there was miscommunication that kept them apart. Once they rediscovered the passion and actually talked, the happily ever after was possible. I enjoyed watching them on this journey and the couple twists and turns only enhanced the ride.

All in all, if you're looking for an enjoyable romance with a Christmas setting, this might be the one for you. It's the second in a duo, but it does stand alone quite well. The characters from book one make a brief appearance and having read the prior book would only enhance that one scene.

She is thrilled to have won the job as she is hoping it will help her mother. Currently visiting a relative, her mother's health is rapidly deteriorating as she declines into early-onset Alzheimers.

When Zoe's mother was diagnosed, Zoe fears that she too may carry the gene for the disease and that to remain married to the Prince would be wrong. She fears that she may pass the gene on to future generations of royals and may also succumb to the disease at an early age adding further burden to Demetrius.

He had fallen hard for Zoe, who was also fun-loving, but who also had some stress going on in her life. They had eloped, marrying in secret, but when he took Zoe home with him things fell apart.

Demetrius was reprimanded for his wild ways and told that he needed to change his ways.
