Large, clear pictures and rhyming text with repetition make this a great choice for a toddler storytime. I also love that it gives you the opportunities to ask little ones to find their feet, tummy, and other basic body parts. A couple of the spreads at the end have much more text on them than the rest, which can lead to antsy toddlers, but it's easy enough to skim over the rhymes and just tell the story to get to the sweet bedtime ending.

Cute! This story combines bathtime with dinosaurs to very great effect. My only quibble (and it's a minor one) is that I wasn't sure if the main character's name should be pronounced "Deeney" or "Dine-y" The story seems to scan just as well either way - just pick a pronunciation and stick with it all the way through. Dini Dinosaur gets dirty and needs to take a bath before bedtime. After jumping in the tub fully clothed, he gradually takes off one layer after another. With a repeating rhyming refrain, "Dirty Dini Dinosaur splashed in the tub. He tried to wash his... with a scrub-a-dub-dub!" this is sure to be a hit at storytime. It's up to Mama Dinosaur to finally set things to rights, giving him a thorough scrubbing before settling down for bed.

The pictures are fantastic and this is a great concept books for clothing. Yet I would not choose it as a read aloud for any child over 2. The primary reason being that most children will be confused by the fact that the mother didn't take Dini's clothes all the way off after the first mishap.

I know this may seem like a minor thing, but it can really throw off the dynamic of a storytime or even an individual read aloud.

The explanation you might try to give would cause more confusion than the original story.

Dini Dinosaur comes in from playing in the mud. It's bath time!

Cute, but I don't know how well it would work for my storytimes. Dini tries to hop in the tub fully clothed and the story is all about how first he has to take off his shoes and then his hat and then his coat... and so on. If I read this with my toddler group, I have one special-needs little boy who will take it as his cue to get undressed. Best for me to skip this one. YMMV

Cute, kids would giggle. But why didn't Mama undress Dini before his bath? Or after his shoes?

This is a very cute story about a dinosaur who gets very dirty while playing in the mud and then has to take a bath to get clean. The repeated refrain of "scrub-a-dub-dub" will make this a fun story that children can participate in reading. Children will also enjoy correcting the dinosaur as he forgets to take off different pieces of clothing before cleaning in the bathtub.

The illustrations, created by Adobe Illustrator, are colorful, but drawn in mostly soft, pastel-like colors. Most pages contain one picture per page, but some pages include a trio of pictures to tell the story of what is happening.
