First thing first, I want to apologise to A.S. Oren because it took too much time for me to start reading this book. After she kindly sent me this book, I promised to read it as soon as I can but I couldn't keep up that promise because some things got in the way (like a big reading slump that I haven't properly recovered from yet). For that, I'm really ashamed.

Ok. Let's move on with the review.

After reading the first volume I was really excited for this one. So why give it 3,5 stars then? I'll try to explain it best I can.

The Characters

Here is the thing. I love Spearwood boys. I do. But there are just too many of them around in the story. Which you think should be normal because Spearwood Academy is a boys school that filled with lots of boys but since we keep meeting new characters when the old ones wasn't handled or developed properly it just left me so confused in the end. I just wish A.S. Oren focused on developing the characters she has instead of introducing new ones. I must admit, I sometimes had difficulties in remembering who was who because there were too many characters around and their relationship with Avalon kept changing or evolving too quickly.

And is it me or Avalon has too many love interests? Thanks God, Amr is not one of them, I guess. I like their relationship!

Saying that, I love Avalon's relationship and connection with the boys. I just don't want it to be a love connection. Except Triton cause you know, I wouldn't mind getting some Triton and Avalon action. Which we did. For a while. *wind wink*. I liked the memory line but then this new Avalon showed up and I was like 'Why are you doing this to me A.S. Oren, whyyyyyy?'

I want some clear answers about why Roseman wants to keep (view spoiler)

Which brings me to... this servant dude. Is anybody really care about Kearn? I was/am praying for him to get lost from the story completely. I still don't understand why Avlon cares about him so much. Dude talked with her what a few times? Dante I would have understood cause he is such a flirt, Horace I'd have understood cause he is such a calm and great guy but the servant guy? I don't get it.

Maverick's character or what's going on with him doesn't make sense, either. Why bully her if you were supposed to protect her? I hope there was an actual reason. Cause if there isn't it doesn't make sense at all.

Paden was such a creep but then he became really tolerable and right now is on the road of becoming a good guy. I'm all in for character development but I want to SEE it actually happening instead of it's just happening so suddenly. The biggest problem with Spearwood boys are sometimes some of them do some shitty stuff and they get away with it. The bad boys personalities change so suddenly I can't keep up. They become tolerable out of nowhere or they just decide to join the team good guys so suddenly. I think the story needs some anti-heroes or strong villains that has purposes. I just don't want them to be there, I want them to come alive in the story. I mean, Avalon keeps forgiving everyone, what is she Mother Teresa? Let bad boys stay as bad boys for a change.

I loved all the pop culture references -with the tv shows, Korean dramas and fanfiction- because I actually got the references but for someone who doesn't get them it'd be a bit annoying to read because there are just so many of them. I must admit though, I LOVED the Boys Over Flowers reference. Not only because it's (both Korean and the Japanese versions) one of my favorite dramas but also because it made a good point. Avalon writes fanfiction about being kidnapped by someone (that your character doesn't like at that moment) because it's just fantasy and dreams about it happening to her but when it actually does happen she admits she didn't actually want it to happen. Ummm....

Lol, that's the thing I don't understand with fanfiction or (normal) writers. Using 'this is a tv show' or 'this is just a story' for every crap thing that doesn't make sense. I always think in these kind of situations a real person would never act like they said so what's the point of saying 'I wish he stalked me' or 'kidnapped me to make me wear fancy clothes so I can look pretty next to him'.
