Both, Liam and Mariah, are very young when they get together for the first time. The author doesn't mention their age but they must be ~ 13/14 and ~ 15/16. This part was hard for me. Liam and Mariah have known each other for a long time. Being next door neighbors, and Liam being Mariah's older brother's best friend has its perks and its downfalls. For Liam, Mariah is like a little sister that he has never had... at first, that is. With a two year difference, Liam being a senior and Mariah being a sophomore their relationship blossoms from the very bottoms of any equation. To Mariah, Liam is just another egotistical, high school jock who broke her heart once during their summer camp relationship. Ever since then, Mariah has not considered him his friend and he detests him. I really enjoyed Nicole London's *Resentment* and while this is a bit similar, it stays within the parameters of high school making this a young adult/new adult book.

Liam is Mariah's brother's best friend but they have all grown up together. The story is told in the present with scenes in the past sprinkled throughout. Those scenes deal with their days at summer camp and something that happened between Liam and Mariah and the reason she now hates him.

There's almost a parallel with what's going on in the present. It's just that Liam has to work a lot harder to get Mariah to talk to him. It certainly helps that Mariah can't really avoid him.
